Local Man Gets \$740 Award For Suggestion On Deployment Bag

A Springfield resident has received an award of \$740 for suggesting and producing an improved deployment bag for missile recovery parachutes, it was reported Saturday.

He is Theodore Hulsizer, 1730 W. Washington st., who works in the parachute fabricating and packing section of the Directorate of Systems Engineering, Aeronautical Systems Division at Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Air Force officials explained:

"With new parachute canopies being designed, it was difficult to use the old deployment bag in which the parachutes were packed. Mr. Hulsizer's design eliminated the problems and has been accepted as a standard article for the Air Force."
